

**INTEGRATED MOBILE SPONSORS 12th ANNUAL STEPHANIE HUMMER
MEMORIAL GOLF TOURNAMENT**

— Tournament Grosses \$18,000 for Local Crime Prevention —

Columbus, Ohio – May 9, 2006 – Integrated Mobile, Inc. today announced the results of the 12th annual Stephanie Hummer Memorial Golf Tournament that was held this past weekend in memory of Stephanie Hummer, a promising young student attending Ohio State University under the Evans Golf Scholarship program, who died tragically in 1994.

One hundred and eight golfers hit the links at Foxfire Golf Club this year, helping to raise an all-time gross high of \$18,000 — by far the best showing since the tournament's inception in 1994. Proceeds benefit crime prevention organizations on or near The Ohio State University campus. The Stephanie Hummer Memorial was established in 1994 by past Evans Scholarship recipients dedicated to creating a legacy in the name of their departed friend. Since its inception in 1994, the Stephanie Hummer Memorial Tournament has grossed more than \$100,000.

"Stephanie was a bright, sweet girl that had a promising future in whatever field she might have ultimately chosen. The Evans Scholars Foundation administers the nation's largest privately funded college scholarship program, the Chick Evans Caddie Scholarship program, providing full tuition and housing grants to deserving caddies. Nearly 8,000 young men and women have graduated from the program. The program was established by and named for Charles "Chick" Evans, Jr., who won 54 tournaments over a competitive career that spanned four decades. He received worldwide fame in 1916 when he won both the U.S. Amateur and the U.S. Open. When he decided to retain his amateur status, he used his golf earnings to establish the Charles Evans Jr. Trust in 1928 to assist golf caddies. The Western Golf Association became the program's sponsor in 1930. For the last two decades, the number of grants in force in any given year has averaged about 825. There are approximately 140 women Scholars. Today, more than a dozen other regional and state golf associations are co-sponsors and affiliates.
